

Testing Timetable – September 2018

10:30am (15 mins before break) – Check watch to gain Blood Glucose Reading.

If reading between 4.0 and 10.0, no action required.

If watch shows under 4.0 or over 10.0, use blood glucose meter to take reading to clarify.

Then:

If reading under 4, treat as per hypoglycemia flowchart.

If reading over 10.0 on blood glucose meter, give correction as offered by machine.

(See giving correction insulin note)

Approx 12:30pm – Use Blood Glucose meter to take reading.

If reading under 4, treat as per hypoglycemia flowchart.

If reading between 4.0 and 10.0, no action required.

If reading over 10.0, give correction as offered by machine.

As long as reading is between 4.0 and 10.0:

Give Insulin for lunch (just before eating)

Fin will have a notebook in his bag listing the total amount of carbs for his lunch. The carbs will need to be typed into the machine to deliver the appropriate amount of insulin.

His blood reading needs to be above 4mmol before he can be given insulin for his lunch.

If at any time, the pump loses connection and you are unsure whether the insulin has gone through, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES should you attempt to deliver again, please ring parents for further advice.

No need for a test in the afternoon (unless he feels low or watch alarms) as I will test when he comes home at 3:15pm.
